CPUC Commissioner Timothy Simon



Timothy Alan Simon was appointed to the California Public Utilities Commission by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger on February 15, 2007.

On the national level, Commissioner Simon is Chair of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) Committee on Natural Gas. He also is a member of Utility Market Access Partnership Subcommittee. Commissioner Simon is a member of the First Friday Caucus, a national educational group on competitive utility markets, the Annual Baseline Assessment of Choice in Canada and the United States (ABACCUS) reporting committee, and the former Chair of the Liquefied Natural Gas

Partnership between NARUC and DOE.

At the state level, Commissioner Simon is a member of the Berkeley Energy & Resources Collaborative at U.C. Berkeley, and the California Green Collar Jobs Council. Prior to joining the CPUC, Commissioner Simon served as the Appointments Secretary to Governor Schwarzenegger.

Commissioner Simon received a Bachelor's degree in Economics from the University of San Francisco, and a Juris Doctor from Hastings College of the Law, University of California. He currently is an adjunct professor of Securities Regulations at the Golden Gate University School of Law in San Francisco, and acts as an advisor on international securities in Golden Gate's U.S. Legal Studies Program.
